### CCNA Discovery

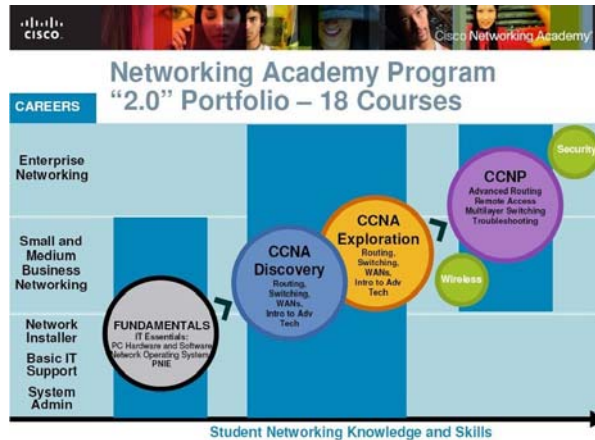

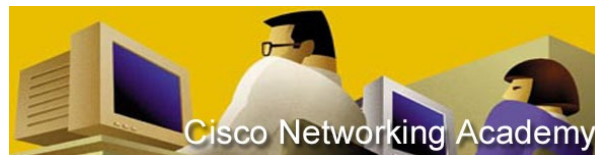
