

Great Progress in Stage Two of Building Programme

A great fence splits Aranui High School in two - a challenge for all staff and students, but the end result will be fantastic new buildings. After the completion of Stage One of the building programme in 2009 (the Science block extensions and the Technology and Art Centre) which caused little inconvenience to the school, the Stage Two location is situated in the very heart of the school. The concrete pad for the first of the teaching pods has now been completed with work progressing on the site works for the second pod.



A team of students has also been working on some designs for the concrete panels on the sides of the new toilet block, which will be next to the Administration building. This will certainly be a most attractive toilet block.

Later in the year the preparations will begin for the removal of the former whanau buildings, which will be reconfigured and extended in their new location between the teaching pods. When the A - D block structure is demolished, the new Technology block and the wharenuī complex will be facing each other.
